- 3 You must have permission from the photographer/owner to use each photograph. Watermarked or photographs with copyright will not be accepted. We accept no responsibility for checking the accuracy of a submitted image.
- 4 Photos should be submitted in jpeg or pdf format
- 5 Entries will be taken through Horse Monkey. One entry form per rider should be completed, and the relevant photographs attached.
- 6 You may submit photographs taken in any year, the combination of horse/rider does not need to be current

## **SEE BELOW FOR HOW TO ENTER :**

- 1. If you are not a Horse Monkey user, before entering you will have to create your profile. Please make sure you include your home address and if possible also include your mobile phone number all these details are entry requirements and storing them will help make payments easier. If you are a member of an association or a riding club please save your Membership number too, your association or club might have special discounts that will apply to your fees.
- 2. Create your Rider and Horse profiles, please make sure complete as many details as possible, if you do it all here you will not need to enter the details later.
- 3. Now you are ready to go!!! (by the way Monkey will save all these details for you so will be able to enter many other events without having to retype the details)

Firstly, find a show that you wish to enter:

- A: If you are searching on our website you will be able to filter by Venue, Association (and other things!) or you can filter by Online Payments so all events that accept payments online are shown
- B: Select the event you want to enter by clicking ENTER NOW
- C: If you have more than one rider, select the rider
- D: Select the horse you are going to compete with
- E: Select the class/es you want to compete in
- F: If you selected a VIRTUAL EVENT OR CLASS ENTER THE LINK TO YOUR VIDEO / IMAGE OR DOCUMENT.
- I: If you want to send a message to the Show Secretary you can do so on by filling in the appropriate section
